On December 10, 2012, I was rolled to an operating room on a hospital bed to undergo the biggest surgery of my life. A team of nationally renowned orthopedic surgeons prepared for the 16 different procedures they were to perform on the lower half of my body all in one long surgery. When I woke up after surgery, I had a hard pill to swallow. I had to start back at square one. I had to learn how to walk again. After eight weeks of being in knee-high casts, knee immobilizers to keep my legs straight, and a wedge to keep them apart, I was projected to have a long recovery. On March 24th, 2013, just three months after my surgery, I took my first independent steps.

Shortly after that day, my parents and I took a trip to visit my surgeons for a checkup. The head surgeon, Dr. Gates, looked at me and said, “Miss Cora, you weren’t predicted to walk until one year post op. Well done.” and it was in that moment that I knew that I was made to be more than people’s expectations of me, and that is exactly the kind of opportunities the Oklahoma FFA Association has given me: Opportunities to exceed the expectation. And because of the blue and gold that I wear, I have done just that.
