



Oklahoma Junior Wheat Show 2021 Results

In all, \$16,000 in scholarships were awarded to participants in this year's Oklahoma Junior Wheat Show sponsored by the Oklahoma Wheat Commission, Oklahoma Wheat Research Foundation, Oklahoma Genetics Incorporated, Westbred, Oklahoma State University and the Oklahoma Department of Career Technology and Education.

Ryder Klaassen, son of Chris and Ginger Klaassen, was awarded the overall grand champion award showing his Doublestop CL Plus variety in the 2021 Oklahoma 4-H/FFA Junior Wheat Show. Klaassen placed 1st in production and milling and 2nd in baking, earning him the title of 1st place as the FFA champion, and overall grand champion of the 4-H/FFA Junior Wheat Show. Klaassen is from the Hydro-Eakly FFA chapter. Klaassen also placed 2nd with his Smith's Gold variety and 2nd in production and milling.
