
"My success is measured by the seeds I sow, not the harvest I reap." - John C. Maxwell

One of the most important critiques I have ever received in a speech room was, “I loved your confidence!” It was my first year giving speeches, and this was one of the first things I was told. I didn’t realize it then, but those words would stick with me throughout the rest of my time in this organization.

As I continued to compete over the years, negative thoughts started to flood my mind: “What if I forget my speech?” “What if I don’t know the answers to my questions?” “What if I talk too fast?” All of these “what ifs” had one theme in common—doubt. However, while these questions were playing in my head, so was that comment about my confidence. What came to the front of my mind was simply to walk in with confidence. Although I may experience self-doubt, I’ve learned that it doesn’t affect me when I enter a situation with confidence.

I share this because I know I am not the only FFA member who has those same “what if” thoughts in the back of their mind. Self-doubt doesn’t just go away, and it may never fully disappear. What I have learned, however, is that it can be refocused. When I stopped letting doubt define me and instead chose to walk in viewing myself as confident, everything changed. Confidence is not the absence of fear, but the decision to move forward despite it. If you change your mindset and see yourself as confident, you can accomplish anything you set your mind to. And most importantly, you are not alone in feeling this way.

As FFA members, how we perform is shaped by how we see ourselves. When we choose to view ourselves as confident and capable, our actions begin to match that mindset. Changing how you see yourself can change what you believe you’re capable of accomplishing.






“Set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.” - 1 Timothy 4:12
