Congratulations on being selected by the State Convention Talent Director to perform at this year's convention! The details of your performance(s), including the date, time, and location(s), are posted here. Once you have identified the location(s) of your performance(s), please review the specific instructions for that location provided below. In the event that you are unable to perform, please notify the state FFA office immediately (trevor.lucas@careertech.ok.gov) so that an alternate member may be selected.

Please note that all selected talent members must wear Official FFA Dress to participate in the state talent program. Members performing a "dance routine" must wear conservative clothing that would be approved by their local school board of education for use at a local school function. Any exceptions to this rule must be cleared through Trevor Lucas at the state office prior to the convention. Please ask your FFA advisor to call Mr. Lucas at 405-743-5461. Female FFA members are required to wear an Official Dress skirt that is no shorter than one inch above the knee, or a nice pair of dress slacks. All male members must be clean-shaven. If you do not follow these requirements, you and your chapter will not be considered for Talent at future FFA conventions!

BOK Arena:

If performing in the BOK Arena, you are required to upload your backing audio tracks for the selected song(s) to the link provided by April 1. *If we do not receive your music by April 1, you will not be performing!* Please clearly identify your name, FFA chapter, and the title of the backing audio track. When saving your track to your computer, please use the format specified below before uploading to file request link below.

Once you have uploaded your track, please send an email to Mr. Barnes at kelly@kellybarnes.com with your contact cell phone number, as well as your FFA advisor's name and cell phone number.

Kelly will program your track into our sound system before the start of the convention. No changes can be made on-site. Obviously, if you are playing an instrument and providing your own sound, you will only be required to send an email to Mr. Barnes with your contact cell phone number, as well as your FFA advisor's name and cell phone number. This is so Mr. Barnes can reach you and/or your FFA advisor if needed on the date of your performance.

You are expected to show up for a ***SOUNDCHECK*** immediately following the conclusion of the General Session just prior to the General Session you will be performing. For example, if you are performing in Session Three, you are required to do your sound check with Mr. Barnes at the conclusion of Session Two. Please check in with Kelly Barnes at the Sound Booth located on the Arena floor level behind delegate seating. During the General Session you are to perform, please find the seat with your name on it in VIP Section One at least 20-minutes before the start of the session. The Arena Talent Manager will escort you backstage at the appropriate time.

Talent Competition: There were three FFA members selected to participate in the preshow talent competition during each of the first five General Sessions. Using the mobile app polling option, FFA members in the Arena will select one winner from each preshow (voting only takes place during the preshow talent). That will make 5 Talent Competition finalists. In addition, one member will be selected by a committee of judges from the Expo talent stage. That makes a total of 6 talent finalists that will participate in the Talent Competition Finals on Wednesday, May 7, 6:00 p.m. The app polling option will again be used during the Talent Competition Finals to select the ***2025 State Convention Talent Winner***. The winner will be announced during the Sixth General Session and will receive a \$1,000 cash award. You are required to perform the exact same music in the Talent Competition Finals that you performed in the General Session preshow. No changes. No exceptions.

To ensure that mobile app voters can correctly identify the candidate they are voting for, we kindly request that you provide a **digital headshot photograph** of yourself in Official FFA Dress. The photo should be taken from the bust-up and will be displayed alongside your name on the mobile app's poll. Please upload your photo to the link provided below no later than **April 1**. *Please note that this is a separate link from the one provided above.*

Expo Talent Stage:

If performing on the Expo Talent Stage, **please bring your backing audio tracks on a laptop or tablet and/or instruments with you** and check-in with the Expo Talent Stage Manager, 15-minutes before you are scheduled to perform. You are required to perform the music that was selected for you by the Talent Director. No changes. No exceptions. We will have all of the necessary hookups for any instruments you might have, so there is no need for you to bring your own cords.

Talent Competition: One talent member performing on the Expo Talent Stage over the course of the two-day convention will be selected by a committee of judges to be one of six finalists in the Talent Competition Finals, Wednesday, May 7, 6:00 p.m., in the BOK Arena. The announcement of this individual will be made at the close of the Fifth General Session in the BOK Arena. This individual will need to check in with Kelly Barnes at the sound booth in the BOK Arena as soon as possible after the announcement has been made. The overall winner will be announced during the Sixth General Session and will receive a \$1,000 cash award. You must perform the exact same music in the Talent Competition Finals that you performed in the Expo. No changes. No exceptions.
